WHAT IS BARASTOC GRAINS & GREENS FEED?

This is a brand new product in the Barastoc poultry feed range. It has been developed as a complete and balanced, high specification feed that is suitable for adult layer birds. The unique blend of whole and cracked grains, seeds and cut lucerne will entice birds and encourage natural foraging behaviour. This product is made from all natural ingredients, and is free from medications, added hormones, artificial colours & flavours.

WHAT IS BARASTOC MIXED FLOCK FEED?

This is a brand new product in the Barastoc poultry feed range. It has been developed as a complete & balanced feed that is suitable for a wide range of bird types and sizes including chickens, ducks, geese, quail, pheasants and guinea fowl, where their primary purpose is not to lay eggs from 12 weeks of age onwards.

CAN I STILL BUY BARASTOC POULTRY GRAIN MIX?

Yes! Poultry Grain Mix is still in the range, it has just been renamed as 3 Grain Scratch Mix.

CAN I STILL BUY BARASTOC LAYER MASH?

Yes! Layer Mash is still in the range, it has just been renamed as Everyday Layer Mash.

CAN I STILL BUY BARASTOC TOP LAYER CRUMBLE?

Yes! Top Layer Crumble is still in the range, it has just been renamed as Champion Layer Pellet.

WHY HAS THE TOP LAYER CRUMBLE CHANGED TO A PELLET?

Top Layer Crumble was always a short-cut pellet, but it was previously called 'crumble' on the pack. So the newly named Champion pellet is actually exactly the same product!

DO BARASTOC POULTRY FEEDS CONTAIN ADDED HORMONES?

NO! Never have, never will.

WHAT TYPES OF POULTRY FEEDS DO BARASTOC PRODUCE?

- Crumble:** Ridley Nutri-bit pellet crushed down to small sized particles suitable for small beaks. Barastoc Chick Starter and Pullet Grower feeds are prepared as a crumble.
- Short Cut Pellet:** Small sized Nutri-bit pellet, which is made from grains, seeds and legumes that are pressed into a moulded pellet. The short cut pellet is suitable for many different bird breeds and sizes. Barastoc Champion Layer, Mixed Flock and Poultry Breeder feeds are prepared as a short-cut pellet.
- Pellet:** Grains, seeds and legumes pressed into a moulded pellet, for ease of feeding and to minimise wastage caused by selective feeding. Barastoc Golden Yolk is prepared as a pellet.
- Mash:** A mix of whole and/or cracked grains and seeds. Barastoc Everyday Layer and Top Layer feeds are prepared as a mash.
- Mix:** A blend of ingredients that could include grains, seeds, pellets, molasses and grasses. Barastoc Darling Downs, Grains & Greens and 3 Grain Scratch are prepared as a mix.

DO BARASTOC POULTRY FEEDS PROVIDE COMPLETE NUTRITION TO MY BIRDS?

All of the Barastoc poultry feeds are nutritious, balanced and complete*. We recommend a Barastoc 'Complete & Balanced' feed makes up the majority of the birds daily intake to ensure a balanced diet. Barastoc 3 Grain Scratch Mix has been designed, not as a complete & balanced feed, but to complement the poultry diet and to encourage natural foraging behaviour.

CAN I FEED MY BIRD SCRAPS?

Yes! We do however recommend a Barastoc 'Complete & Balanced' feed makes up the majority of the birds daily intake to ensure a balanced diet. Other feeds such as green scraps, pasture and hay may also be fed, but we recommend only in small amounts.

WHAT ARE BARASTOC POULTRY FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS?

- Ensure birds have continuous access to feed – do not restrict consumption.
- Self-feeders designed for poultry are a good way to ensure feed is continuously available.
- Ensure birds have access to clean, fresh water at all times.

*3 Grain Scratch Mix is not intended to be used as a complete feed.

WHAT IS COCCIDIOSIS?

Coccidiosis is a common digestive disease that occurs in young birds, caused by an intestinal parasite. It generally occurs because of damp ground or litter in the hen house, which encourages the development of the 'oocyst' - the infectious stage of the coccidiosis life cycle.

Beyond the point of lay birds will generally have developed an immunity to coccidiosis, however young birds are vulnerable.

For this reason, Barastoc Chick Starter and Pullet Grower feeds contain an anti-coccidiosis, which helps protect young birds against coccidiosis.

ARE THE INGREDIENTS USED IN THESE PRODUCTS SOURCED FROM AUSTRALIA?

Yes! Barastoc poultry feeds are proudly made in Australia using ingredients sourced from Australian farmers.

WHAT IS THE SHELF LIFE OF THE PRODUCTS?

6 months from date of manufacture.

TO WHAT STANDARD DO BARASTOC MANUFACTURE THE FEED TO?

Barastoc is a FeedSafe® Accredited Manufacturer. This is an accreditation issued by the Stock Feed Manufacturers Council of Australia (SFMCA).

FeedSafe® is a program aimed at increasing the commitment of the Australian stock feed industry to quality assurance and risk mitigation in the manufacture and use of animal feeds. The SFMCA through FeedSafe® has recognised the need for a broader industry approach to feed and food safety and is providing greater security of supply to Australia's livestock industries. Feed manufacturers are required to implement HACCP as part of their accreditation. To obtain FeedSafe® accreditation, feed manufacturers are required to undergo annual site audits, these being conducted by independent third party auditors.

HOW SHOULD BARASTOC POULTRY FEEDS BE STORED?

We recommend for optimum quality and shelf life Barastoc poultry feeds should be stored below 30°C and off the floor in a cool, dry well ventilated area protected from direct sunlight.

CAN THE POULTRY FEED BAGS BE RECYCLED?

While the material can be recycled, there are few options that exist in Australia that allow this to happen, as it is not able to be collected via kerbside rubbish collection. We instead ask that people dispose of the packaging thoughtfully.
