 3. To achieve optimal efficacy, iO TICK OFF DUO relies on a combination of absorption through the skin and oral ingestion (via grooming). For oral ingestion it is critical that the product is applied as 2 x 7 cm wide bands, from the shoulder to the rump, that are well separated on either side of the spine. Use an approved iO 30ml applicator with soray nozzle.

 4. The weight of cattle should be determined by either scales or a weighband.

 1.5 mg fluazuron and 0.5 mg ivermectin
