



INSECTICIDAL SPRAY AND RINSE CONCENTRATE FOR DOGS AND HORSES

ANIMAL	PEST	DILUTION	CRITICAL COMMENTS
DOGS	Fleas	10mL per 400mL of water or methylated spirits (if rapid drying is required)	Spray animal entirely ruffling the coat to ensure adequate penetration and coverage. Use weekly. Spray or rinse as above daily until symptoms are controlled, then as required.
	Flea Allergy Dermatitis	10mL per 400mL of water	In paralysis tick areas, daily searching for and removal of any ticks found is necessary.

HORSES	Stable Fly	10mL per 400mL of water	Spray as required for fly nuisance. For Queensland Itch [Culicoides bite hypersensitivity] spray twice weekly until symptoms abate, then as required.

INDICATIONS:

HORSES: Control of pyrethroid sensitive flies buffalo fly (*Haematobia irritans exigua*), stable fly (*Stomoxys calcitrans*) and biting insects (*Culicoides* spp) on horses. An aid in the treatment of Queensland Itch.

DOGS: Control of fleas (*Ctenocephalides felis*, *Ct canis*) and ticks (adult *Rhipicephalus* sp.). An aid dermatitis (summer eczema).

ZONE CONTROL:

To obtain maximum flea control, treat the animal's environment by cleaning the bedding and resting places and then regularly spraying the entire area with the diluted product. Treat all pets in the house with a suitable product. Vacuum / clean the carpets and surroundings regularly. Continue treatment all year round. If flea problems persist, seek veterinary advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product should not be used on cats and animals under 12 weeks of age. When diluted in methylated spirits, the product should not be used on broken skin.

Q: Can Permetrol be used on cats?

A: No

Q: I have a puppy/foal, can I apply Permetrol?

A: Only apply Permetrol to animals over 12 weeks old.

Q: I use a product called Permaxin, is this the same?

A: Yes

Q: Can I apply Permetrol directly onto my animals skin undiluted?

A: No, you need to dilute into water or methylated spirits referring to the recommended dose rate.

Q: Where is this product made?

A: At our GMP approved manufacturing facility in Sydney.

Q: I bought my bottle a while ago and it says it's out of date, can I still use it?

A: No, the safest option is to purchase an in-date bottle.

Q: Once I've diluted the Permetrol into a spray bottle with water, how long will that last for?

A: We recommend using that solution within 2-3 weeks.

Q: How long will a 250mL bottle last me?

A: Depending on seasonal conditions and the number of animals you have, a 250mL bottle makes 25 applications OR 10L of diluted solution.

Q: I have a horse show coming up and would like to make sure the solution is fast-drying, what would you recommend?

A: Permetrol is safe to dilute with methylated spirits and helps to dry a lot quicker than water.

Q: Does Permetrol protect against paralysis ticks?

A: Although clinical trials show that the ingredient Permethrin protects against paralysis ticks for almost 14 days, the product doesn't make this claim on the label.

Q: My horse/dog has gone swimming in water, do I need to reapply?

A: Yes

Q: How long will Permetrol protect my horse/dog from ticks?

A: For up to two weeks, however we always recommend checking your animal every two days in tick-prone areas.

Q: Can I apply Permetrol to my goat/pig/cow/chickens?

A: The product is only registered to be used on horses and dogs. Please consult your vet for further application advice.

Q: Can I apply to surface areas near my animal?

A: Yes, we recommend using it for zone control to help keep flies and insects under control. Apply to rugs, floats, kennels and stables for best results.

Q: Where can I purchase Permetrol?

A: Your preferred horse feed supplier or pet shop, along with rural retailers, saddleries and online stores.
